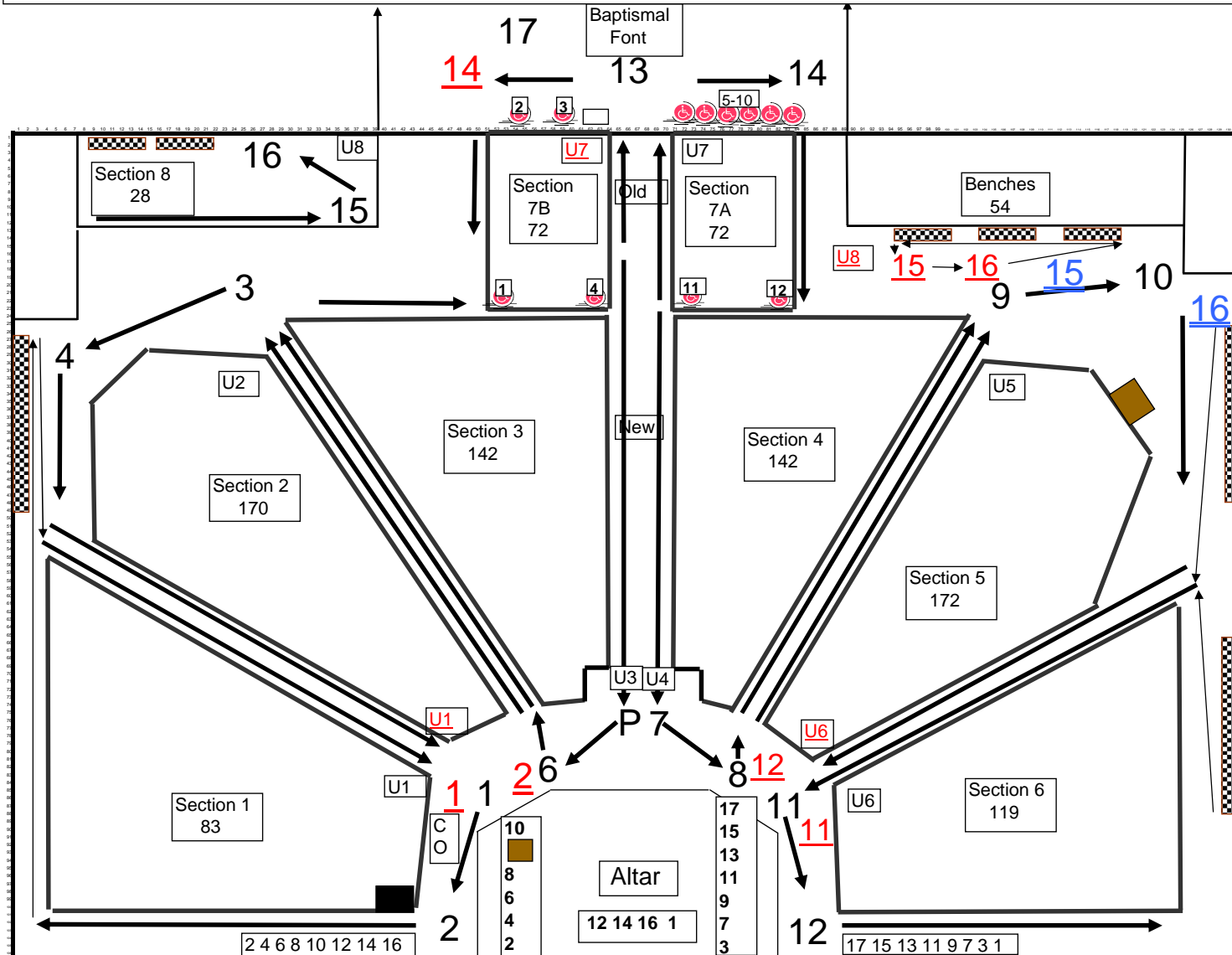


Total 1055 i.e. full church

EM'S - Odd #'s Host - even #'s Chalice - black arrows people flow - red numbers underlined ministers second location - blue numbers double underlined third location

EM's 1&2 start in section 1 including the benches, then finish up section 2. First doing the Cantor and Organist, then the first row and then proceed to their locations. EM's 3&4 do section 2, EM's P&6 do section 3, EM's 7&8 or D do section 4. EM's 9&10 do section 5, EM's 11&12 do section 6 and the benches. If they finish before section 5 they should move to the front of section 5. EM's 13&14 do sections 7A first and then 7B. EM's 15&16 do section 8 (Inside the cry room), then benches opposite side then help finish section 5. EM 17 does the handicapped in section 7B, then anyone standing, then helps EM 13 with section 7A. When 7A is finished he does the handicapped in 7A and then assists EM 13 with section 7B. EM's 3,4,P,6,7,8 or D, 9, 10 and 13 never move.

The EM's come forward at the Lamb of God. Cups on the left side and Hosts on the right side. The EM's should line up in order at the foot of the steps prior to going up on the Altar. The cups should line up between the front wall and section 1 and the Hosts between the front wall and section 6. When 16 sees his side EM's are in place he should look across at 17. If his side is in place he should be facing 16 and they should proceed to the Altar together. All EM's try to distribute to the handicapped people in their section last. The Cantor and Organist will stand in front of section 1 and be ministered first.



Ushers

For Communion -

Usher #1 does section 1 from the front and then the benches in the back and then section 2 from the front.
 Usher 2 does section 2 from the back.
 Usher 3 does section 3 from the front. He continues until he meets usher 7 in the back.
 Usher 4 does section 4 from the front.
 Usher 5 does section 5 from the back.
 Usher 6 does section 6 from the front.
 When finished he directs benches to follow. If he finishes before section 5, he starts section 5 from the front.
 Usher 7 does section 7A first and then section 7B.
 Usher 8 does section 8 and then the benches on the other side.

For the Offertory -

Usher 1 goes up section 1 from the left side and then the benches and then the seat in section 3 between the pillars.
 Usher 2 goes up section 2 from the left side.
 Usher 3 goes up section 3 from the center aisle.
 Usher 4 goes up section 4 from the center aisle.
 Usher 5 goes up section 5 from the right side.
 Usher 6 goes up section 6 from the right side and then the benches. He then proceeds to the seat in section 4 between the pillars.
 Usher 7 goes up the center and does both sections 7A and 7B.
 Usher 8 does section 8 and any people standing. Usher 8 should talk to the people behind section 3, before Mass, to tell them to please remain seated for Communion until the Usher directs them up the center aisle.
 The two benches by the back wall will be reserved for the ushers.
